He completed 10th grade at Lee Shau Kee High School in 2015 before continuing his education at the International School of Minnesota, where he graduated with honors in 2018. He went on to earn a Bachelor of Science in Chemistry, graduating summa cum laude with distinction from the University of Minnesota Twin Cities in 2022. Motivated to reduce disparities in access to oral health care between urban

and rural communities, Dylan is currently pursuing a Doctor of Dental Surgery degree at the University of Minnesota School of Dentistry (UMNSOD), with an expected graduation in May 2026. Aside from clinical care, Dylan's passion for research began early during his undergraduate years at the Minnesota Dental Research Center for Biomaterials and Biomechanics (MDRCBB), where he co-authored two publications and earned third place in the 2021 Paffenbarger Award at the Academy of Dental Materials Annual Meeting. In dental school, he continued his research through the 2023 UMN Summer Research Fellowship and was selected to represent UMNSOD in the 2024 Dentsply Sirona Student Competition for Advancing Dental Research and its Application (SCADA) at the IADR/AADOCR annual meeting in New Orleans. Committed to public health, Dylan teamed up with his dental peers and established dental services at the student-run, interprofessional Phillips Neighborhood Clinic.
